

FREESTYLE REGISTRATION AND FEES

Session runs for 27 weeks

From Sept. 25, 2011 to April 1, 2012

Low Freestyle: - \$500

- Basic, Pre-preliminary, & Preliminary Freestyle
- Through Adult Pre-Bronze FS

High Freestyle: - \$750

- Passed Intermediate Freestyle
- Passed Adult Silver

Middle Freestyle: Adult Silver, Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile skaters may choose to contract as either high or low skaters

Administrative fee: \$40 per skater / year

Gertrude Hawk candy sale fundraiser to defray rising ice costs – all members.

USFS Registration fee: Skaters are responsible for paying their USFS registration fees.

Registration:

At the New Hartford Recreation Center on:

- Family membership discount of 10% for 3 or more family members
- Fees cannot be pro-rated and are non-refundable after the start of a session
- Payment plans of 50% before skating, with two equal payments on 10/31 and 11/30.

Joint Memberships

Available to members of other USFS home clubs

- Annual membership fee - \$65
- 1st hour of Freestyle - \$150
- 2nd hour of Freestyle - \$120

Drop In Skaters

Available to members of other USFS home clubs (if space is available)

\$15 / session (45-60 minutes, generally)

Punch Cards – Covers 10 drop in sessions

\$110 – Full SCNH Members

\$140 – All others

MEMBER ICE PRIVILEGES

- OPEN sessions are available to ALL full-package members
- Low sessions are for low freestyle skaters only
- High sessions are for middle and high freestyle skaters only
- Middle skaters must contract as either high or low skaters; they may not switch between levels from session to session.

Exceptions to skate on ice not appropriate for skater test level must be asked for in writing, in advance, by a club professional.

Jump Harness

- Harness needs to be reserved in advance.
- Guest skaters and/or coach may reserve harness if available the day of a lesson and pay in advance - \$5 for a 15 minute session.

Club Coaching Policy

The Skating Club has a group of highly qualified skating professionals who are available to provide private lessons at ALL levels and in ALL disciplines of individual skating. We encourage our member skaters to utilize these coaches whenever possible.

LOW Freestyle skaters are especially encouraged to approach club coaches regarding interest and availability PRIOR to exploring guest coach options, please see a Board Member if you have any questions or concerns.

Middle and High Freestyle Skaters who are full or joint members of SCNH may have any coach they choose provide them lessons on their appropriate level, contracted ice-time. Guest Coaches – coaches who are not Club Coaches - may NOT request lesson exceptions, even for member skaters.

Guest Coaches must pay a \$5 / Day Guest Coach fee if they coach any non-member on club ice, including a partial session where they have coached a contract club member.
