Drop In Procedure - Freestyle Ice Only

2021/2022

Drop in's will be allowed at the Skating Club of New Hartford on Freestyle Ice. However, we have an ice cap. Therefore, we can NOT guarantee a space for you. We prefer if you call our club Treasurer, Shelley Athari, as she has taken charge of the Freestyle Ice during this time. Her cell is 315-335-1373. We will then put your name on the list for the session.

Drop In Rates

\$20.00 Per Session: You may bring a USFSA registered coach with you for no extra charge (*see below*). You may buy a 10 session punch card for \$180. Make checks payable to: SCNH

Rules

- You must fill out a Liability Waiver prior to stepping on the ice.
 - *To be kept on file for the 21-22 Season.*
- You must obey the SCNH Rink Rules & Procedures.
- You must be able to prove you are currently registered with USFSA.
- You must pay before entering the ice.
- Using Non-SCNH Coaches during your session:

There is no extra charge to have your non-SCNH coach give you a lesson on our ice during your session. However, we must have the following in advance of your coach coming to your session:

- Your coaches proof of an active USFS membership
- Proof of current professional liability (\$1M)
- Appropriate CER completion each season
- Learn to Skate USA membership and credentialing, *if applicable*

Session monitors are parent volunteers and will NOT have the ability or knowledge to check your coach's credentials at the door. These must be submitted and approved before you bring your coach to your ice session. Your coach must also sign our Coaching Code of Conduct.

If you'd like to bring your coach, please send an email to SCofNH@gmail.com with your coaches name, USFSA # and phone number. We will do our best to get all the information we need from them prior to your session. Please allow a week for processing.

- If you drop into a session which runs consecutive to Stroking - you may skate Stroking without additional charge. If you remain on the ice during a Stroking Session, you must participate in Stroking.

Note:

Joint Membership is available and covers Oct 2020 - March 2021 (*approx 24 weeks this year*). This option guarantees you a specific session(s) each week at a much lower rate per session. You can also buy onto our Style Session.

Joint Membership Pricing: Current Annual Fee + \$160 for 1st Session + \$130 for each add'l session. Stroking is \$130.
